



## Call for Tutorials of ASRU 2023

ASRU 2023 is excited to announce a Tutorial Day, scheduled for December 15, 2023, one day prior to the workshop. We cordially invite tutorial proposals in all areas of speech and language processing, as well as their applications. Tutorials should be 3 hours in duration and may introduce an emerging or currently active area of speech-related research or provide an overview of an established research area. Proposals featuring speakers who will present in person in Taiwan are highly preferred. Attendees will have the option to participate in the tutorial either in-person or remotely.

Proposals should not exceed two pages and must include the following essential information:

- Tutorial title
- Presenter name(s), contact information, brief biography, representative recent related publications, and indication of whether the presentation will be in person
- A summary of the presenter's previous tutorial delivery experience
- The rationale for the tutorial, including its importance and timeliness
- A detailed description of the tutorial, outlining the topics and subtopics covered

Tutorial proposals will undergo a peer-review process based on the provided information.
